






Applicants from 50 states

GPAs by matriculation status








Age by matriculation status






Gender by matriculation status








What percentage of matriculants belong to each demographic group?







Matric. Rates by disadv. status

Family income economically disadvantaged






What percentage of programs *received* applicants from various demographic groups?

Of all programs *receiving* applicants from that group, what percentage *matriculated* at least one applicant from that group?


Programs receiving: Gender




Programs receiving: Ethnicity




Programs receiving: Race

Summary

- First decline in total applicants
- Use CASPA data to demonstrate commitment to diversity!
- Wide variation in numbers across programs
- Consistent patterns in applicants/matriculants
- Underrepresented groups continue to matriculate at lower rates
- Even when receiving applicants from certain groups, not all programs matriculate students from that group



HRSA indicators

- I participated in an academic enrichment program funded in whole or in part by the Health Careers Opportunity Program.
- I am a high-school drop-out who received AHS diploma or GED.
- I have a diagnosed physical or mental impairment that substantially limits my participation in educational experiences and opportunities offered by a college.
- I was accepted to the health professions program after academic reassessment at the completion of remedial courses.
